Trash/Dumpsters/Recycling

Laundry Facilities/Bathrooms

Located in all YC bathroom buildings Open 24/7/Coin operated showers

Dumping Station

Located behind dumpsters near store/office

Security Gate

During Peak Season gate will be in operation 24/7 requiring a gate card Gate cards can be secured in store

Dumpsters are located by Office/Store/Shop

Household trash only in dumpsters

NO PROPANE bottles may be placed in dumpster

Please use appropriate recycling dumpsters (Bottles-Cans/Paper)

Swimming Pool

There is NO lifeguard on duty. Supervision of Minors is required. The Pool is generally open from 9 am until dusk. All posted pool rules must be obeyed, Diapers are not allowed.

Beach Passes

Town of Kennebunk requires a beach pass from June-September, passes are available at the Kennebunk Town Hall and at beach kiosks.

River Access

No swimming is allowed in the river area. Supervision of minors at all times by river is required. All canoes/small boats stored there are privately owned and are not the property of the Campground. River area and road to river is open to campers from 7:30 a.m. and closes at dusk to all.

LPG Gas

If you need to purchase LPG gas we can fill 20 and 30 lb tanks during office hours. Inquire at the office.

Rules

- Quiet Hours are between 11PM-8AM. Minimal noise levels shall be maintained during these hours.
- All minors (18YOA) must be on their sites no later than 11PM
- No bike riding after dark.
- No more than six people per site, and no more than two vehicles may be parked on one site.
- All children/minors are the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
- Vulgarity, fighting, drunkenness, and disorderly conduct will not be tolerated.
- No out of state firewood is allowed per Maine State Law.
- All fires must be in fire rings provided by YC. Fires must be extinguished at the end of the night. Fires may not be left unattended. Cutting of YC trees or limbs is prohibited. No burning of leaves and or garbage is permitted.
- All visitors must register at camp store during office hours.
- Pets of transient campers are allowed, no guest may bring a pet while visiting a transient camper. All pets must be monitored/leashed by their owners at all times. Barking/loud and aggressive pets will not be tolerated. Pet feces must be picked up.
- Pool use is in accordance to posted rules. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a supervising adult.
- The use of, display and possession of firearms, air arms, paintball guns, fireworks, explosives, weapons and illegal drugs or substances is strictly prohibited. Violation of this rule will result in the notification of authorities and immediate eviction.
- Alcohol beverages are permitted, but drunkenness and loud disorderly behavior will not be tolerated.
- State law prohibits the discharge of gray/black water onto the ground. Use the dumping station.
- Motorized bikes/scooters/dirt bikes/ATV's are prohibited. Drones and hover-boards are prohibited.
- Electric/Water Transient sites may be reserved for up to 2 weeks.
- Monthly full hook-up RV site pre-paid rates are offered for rent when they are available. See information and all details on Monthly rental RV sites.
